

COVID – 19 Madrasah/Parents Agreement

Madrasah:

The Madrasah will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection
- Maintain high levels of health, hygiene, and safety through rigorous and regular cleaning, washing and sanitising of hands and use of PPE when required. However, we are unable to guarantee a virus free Madrasah
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we possibly can
- Provide a learning environment that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs to the best of our ability
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement
- Communicate between home and Madrasah through either text, email or the Madrasah website

I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing of 1 metre in the corridor and in the car park
- Use the hand sanitiser before entering the class and upon leaving the class
- Bring my own things, as borrowing will not be allowed
- Tell an Apa or Maulana if I feel unwell
- Not bring things into Madrasah from home that have not been agreed by Madrasah
- Only use the equipment provided to me by Madrasah and no other
- Not mix with any other children in the other Madrasah class bubble
- Only enter and exit the Madrasah building from the designated entry/exit points
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it).
- Follow good hand hygiene - use hand sanitiser
- Always behave well to maintain the safety of myself and others
- Ask for help from my class teacher, if I need help or support
- Follow these expectations and know if I do not, there will be serious consequences, as Madrasah will not tolerate risks to other people's health

Parent

Parent/Carer.....

To help my child at Madrasah, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to Madrasah, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family. I will get them tested and I will let the Madrasah know as soon as possible, if we test positive via telephone
 - If my child, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at Madrasah, I will collect my child from Madrasah immediately
 - On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the social distancing rules
 - When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the Madrasah timings for my child
 - I will not be able to stop and speak to members of staff or others
 - My child must not bring any items into Madrasah with them other than the items agreed by Madrasah
 - I will ensure my children are prepared, do wudhu from home and go to the bathroom. They will only be allowed if they have a medical condition or in dire measures, for their own safety
 - I will send a named water bottle with my child, they won't be allowed out for water
 - My child may have their temperature taken on arrival and during the day if they feel or present as being unwell
 - My child will not be allowed to mix with other children of other classes
 - My child will not be allowed out of the class, unless absolutely necessary
 - I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
 - My child will need to use good hand hygiene
 - My child will have washed before arriving to Madrasah, wudhu will not be allowed in Madrasah
 - If my child falls seriously ill, Madrasah will contact Medical services
 - I will not be allowed into the Madrasah and all contact will be via telephone or email
 - I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis
 - The Staff will try to maintain common sense in terms of social distancing whilst working with the children. However, they are caring for the children and therefore may at times work within the metre, with a face mask, gloves etc
 - Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent on WhatsApp or E-Madrasah App
- If my child is absent, I understand that sabak will be updated on e – madrasah daily
- I need to inform the Madrasah immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details
 - If my child is deemed unsafe due to not abiding by the rules, he/she will be sent home and will not return to Madrasah until the Principal is reassured that my child will behave safely.
 - If it becomes impossible for Madrasah to remain open because of a COVID outbreak or staffing shortages, we may have to close Madrasah with very short notice

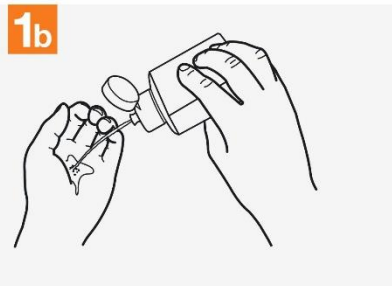
How to Handrub?

RUB HANDS FOR HAND HYGIENE! WASH HANDS WHEN VISIBLY SOILED

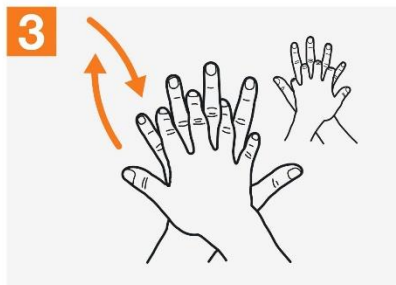
 **Duration of the entire procedure: 20-30 seconds**



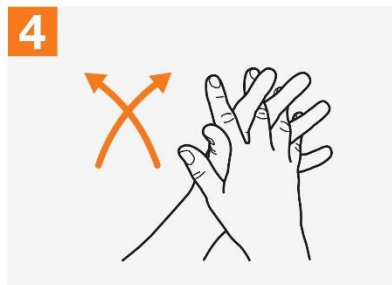
1a Apply a palmful of the product in a cupped hand, covering all surfaces;



2 Rub hands palm to palm;



3 Right palm over left dorsum with interlaced fingers and vice versa;



4 Palm to palm with fingers interlaced;



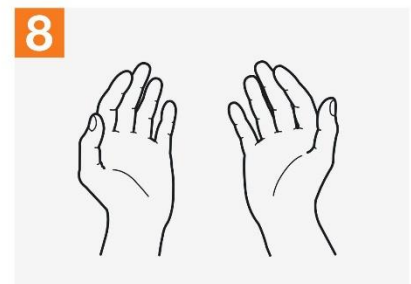
5 Backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked;



6 Rotational rubbing of left thumb clasped in right palm and vice versa;



7 Rotational rubbing, backwards and forwards with clasped fingers of right hand in left palm and vice versa;



8 Once dry, your hands are safe.
